Nokia has announced two new phones namely the Nokia 100 and 101. The Nokia 100 and 101 are identical with the difference being that the Nokia 100 is a single SIM phone while the Nokia 101 is dual-SIM. Also the Nokia 101 supports memory card expandable up to 16GB and has a built in MP3 player and application support.

Both Nokia phones come with flashlight and run of the Nokia series 30 operating system. The phones are specifically targeted to Africa and Asia and hence designed with challenges of using mobile phones in those regions in mind. For example, the phones offer great battery life with up to 25 days on standby and 6.7 hours talktime.

The Nokia 101 (pictured) is a dual-SIM phone and can remember details of up to five SIM cards with support for up to five separate phonebooks.

I once said in an [earlier post](#) how Nokia came late to the dual SIM market but with this enhanced features that i am seeing in their new crops of Dual-SIM devices, i can confidently say that it may have been worth the wait for people who held off buying Dual-SIM phones of other phone manufacturers.

Nokia 101 and 100 will be available this quarter and will cost (excluding taxes and subsidies) around €25 (N5,500) and €20 (N4,400) respectively.
